

Nearly 20 percent of first-time, full-time freshmen at Tennessee public four-year institutions are not retained into their second year.


The six-year graduation rate has increased overall, but fallen for Black, Hispanic, and Pell-eligible students.

Hispanic students' annual wages increase the most quickly post-graduation of any student group.



Average ACT Of Entering Students




ACT Score Distribution Of Entering Students





Rate Of Students Earning At Least 24 Credits In Year One






