Dr. Heinrich's research focuses on education, workforce development, health and social welfare policy, program evaluation, and public management. She works with government agencies to improve policy design and program effectiveness and collaborates with nongovernmental organizations to improve the impacts of economic and social protection investments in middle-income and developing countries. In 2004, Heinrich received the David N. Kershaw Award for distinguished contributions to the field of public policy analysis and management and was elected to the US National Academy of Public

Administration in 2011. She has served as president of the Association for Public Policy Analysis and Management and the Public Management Research Association and held the George Eastman Professorship at the University of Oxford for the 2022-23 academic year. Heinrich holds a PhD from the University of Chicago.
