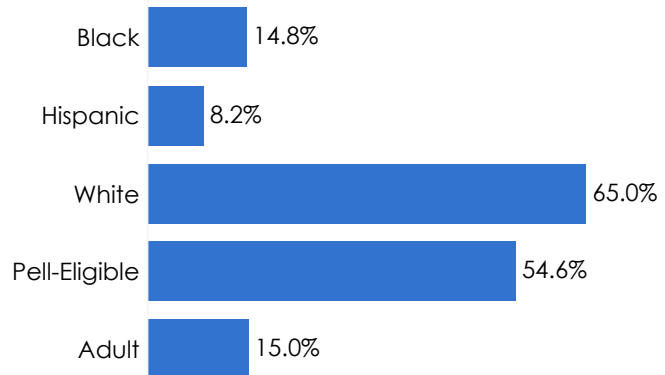

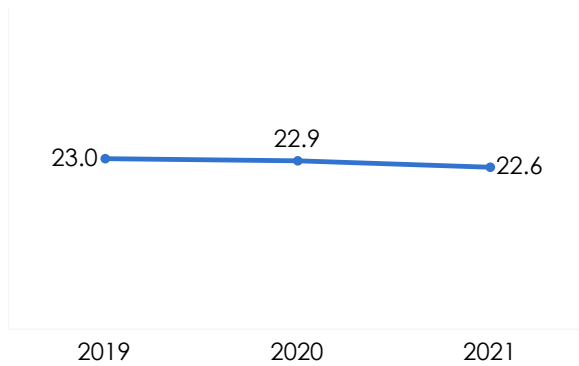
- 1** In Fall 2022, Middle Tennessee State University enrolled the second highest number of students across all Tennessee public four-year institutions (17,535).
- 2** Middle Tennessee State University had the third highest first-to-second-year retention rate of Pell-eligible students for the entering cohort of 2021 across all Tennessee public four-year institutions (76.6 percent).
- 3** Middle Tennessee State University had the third highest rate of 24 credits accumulated in the first year for the entering cohort of 2021 across all Tennessee public four-year institutions (75.9 percent).
- 4** Middle Tennessee State University had the second highest growth in the six-year graduation rate across all Tennessee public four-year institutions (2.5 points).

All Students Performance Over Time



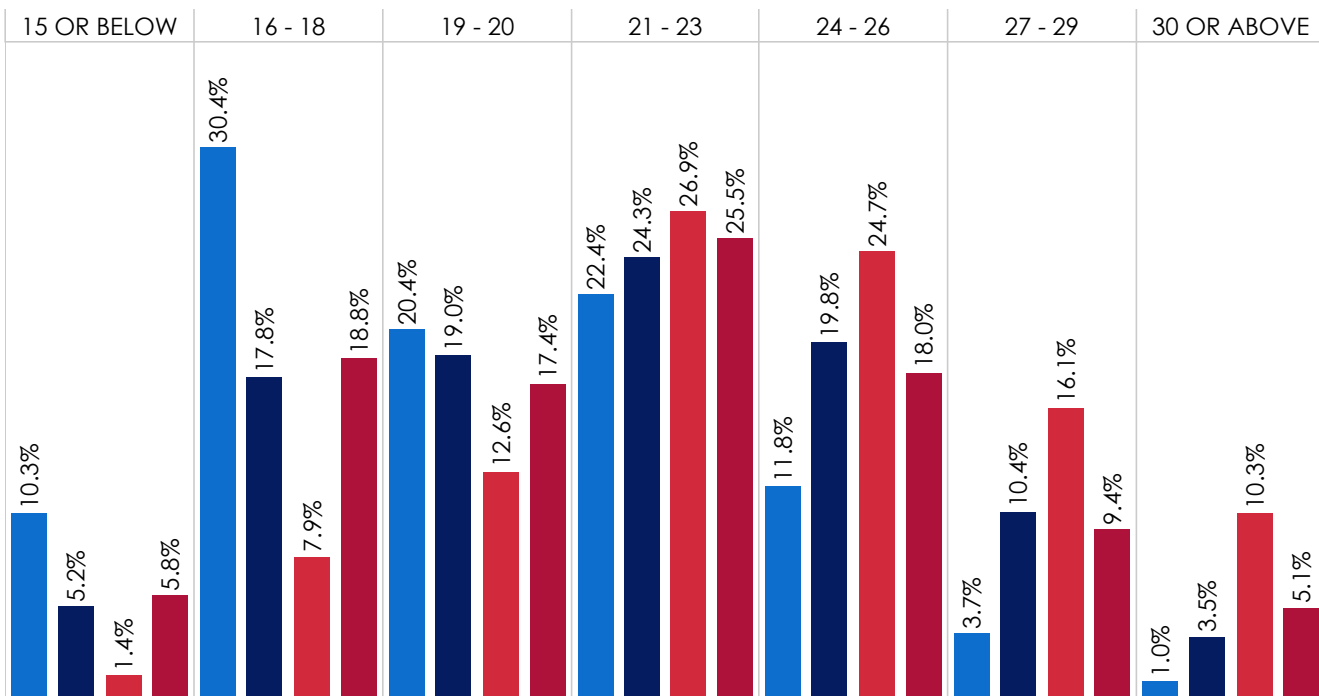
2021 Performance By Student Group

 ■ Pell-Eligible

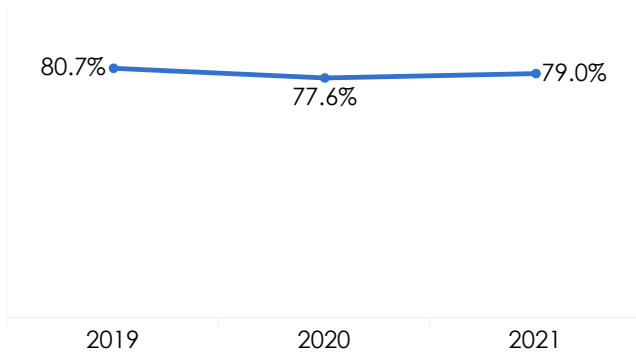

All Students Performance Over Time

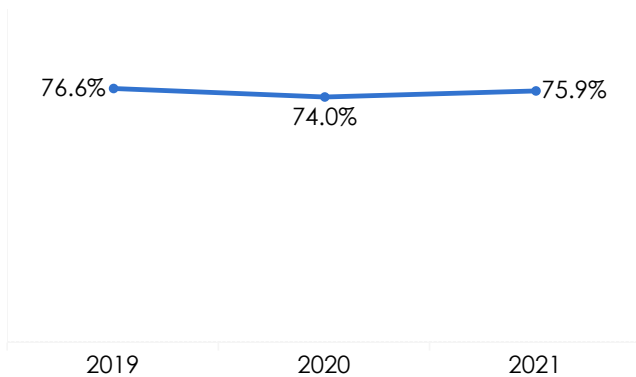


2021 Performance By Student Group

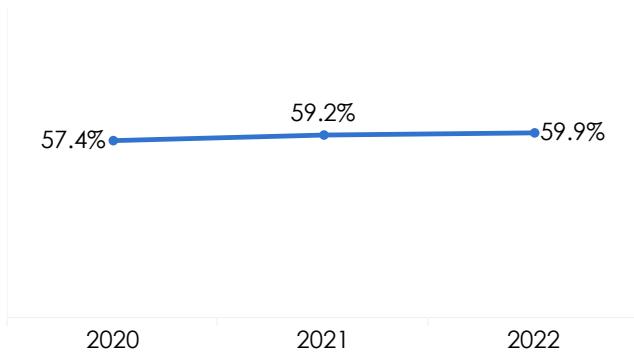

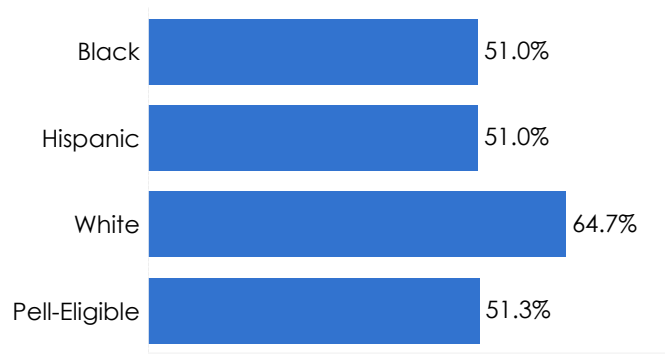

All Students Performance Over Time

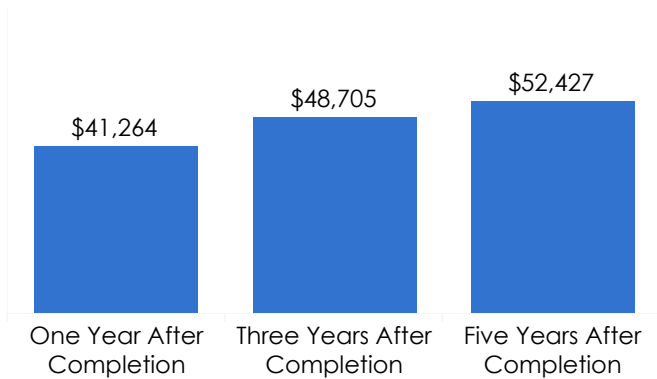


2022 Performance By Student Group
