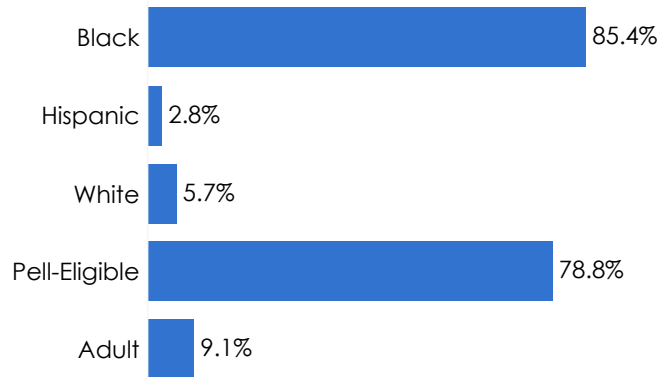

## Key Takeaways

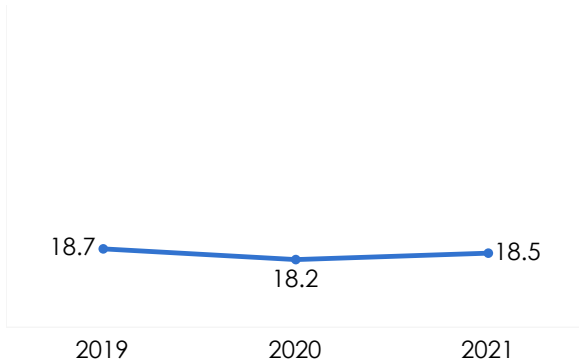
- 1** In Fall 2022, Tennessee State University enrolled the highest percentages of Pell-eligible students and Black students of any Tennessee public four-year institution (78.8 percent, 85.4 percent).
- 2** Tennessee State University had the lowest first-to-second-year retention rate for the entering cohort of 2021 of any Tennessee public four-year institution (62.7 percent).
- 3** Tennessee State University had the lowest six-year graduation rate of Pell-eligible students in the entering cohort of 2016 of any Tennessee public four-year institution (31.7 percent).
- 4** Tennessee State University had the second highest median annual wage five years post-graduation for Black students in the class of 2017 across all Tennessee public four-year institutions (\$50,540).

All Students Performance Over Time



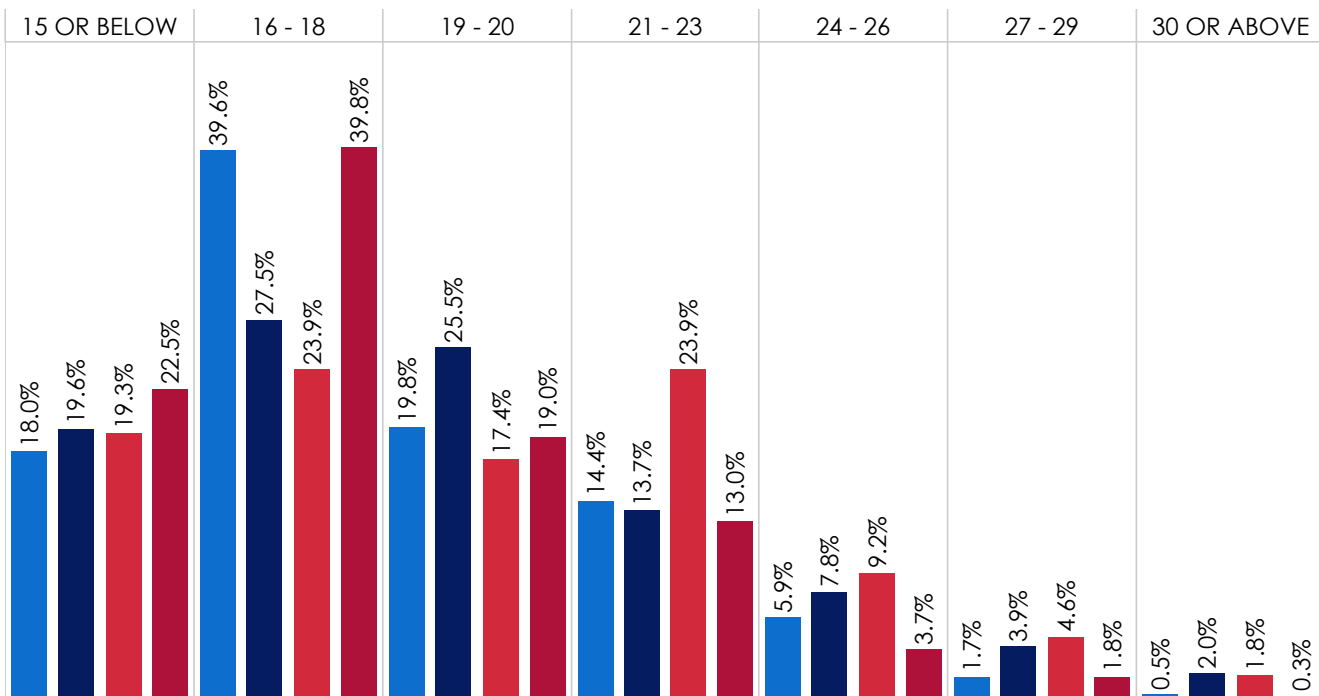
2021 Performance By Student Group

 ■ Pell-Eligible

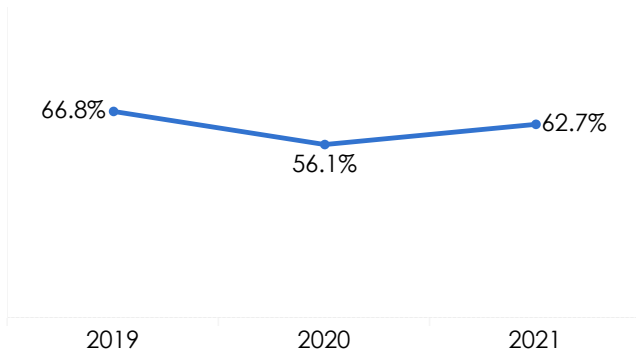

All Students Performance Over Time

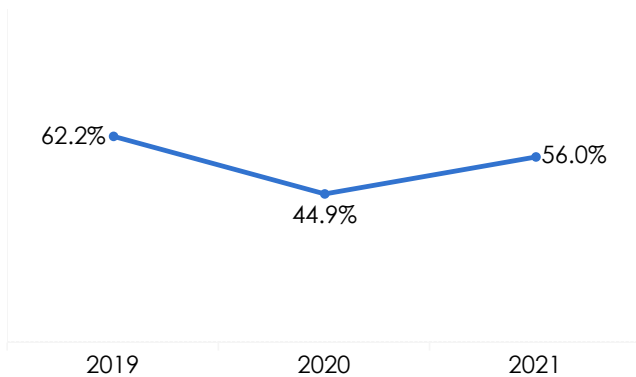


2021 Performance By Student Group

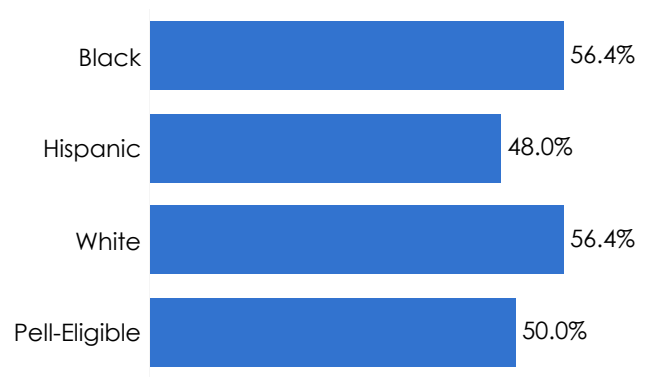


### Rate Of Students Earning At Least 24 Credits In Year One

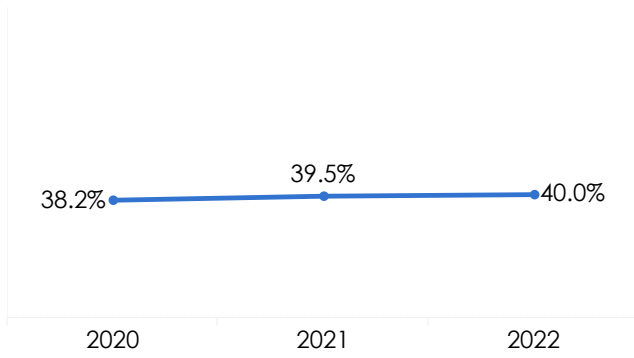

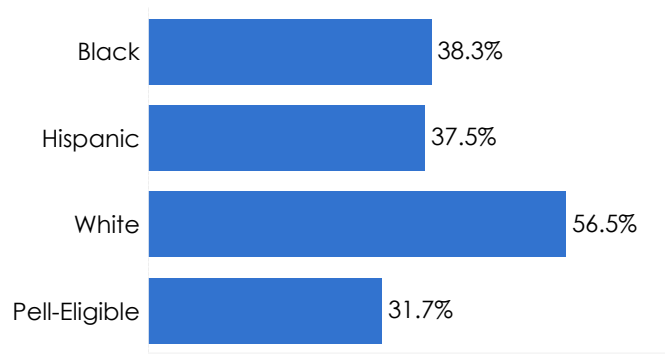

All Students Performance Over Time

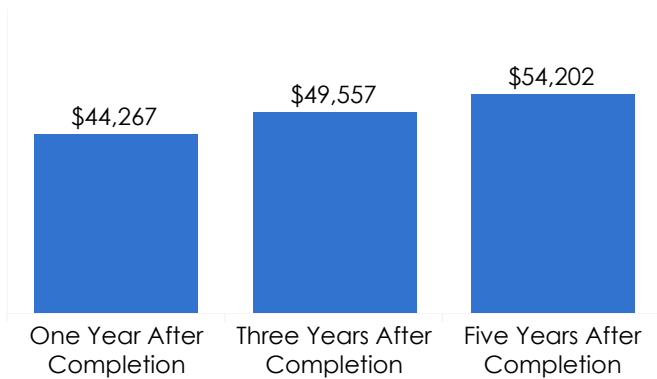


2022 Performance By Student Group
