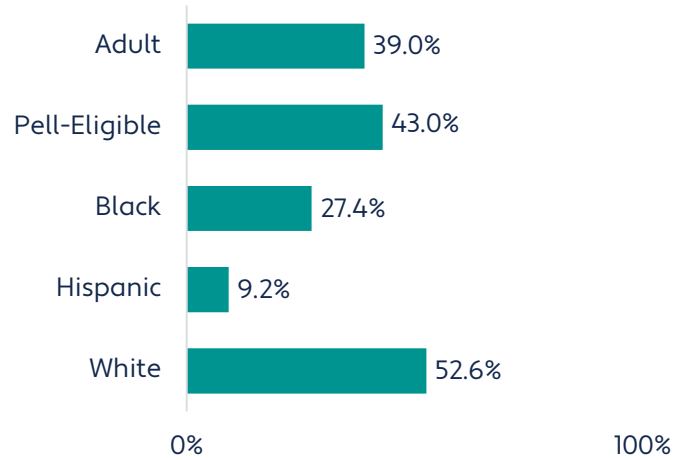

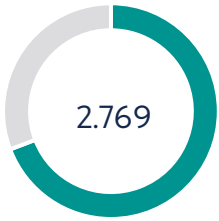

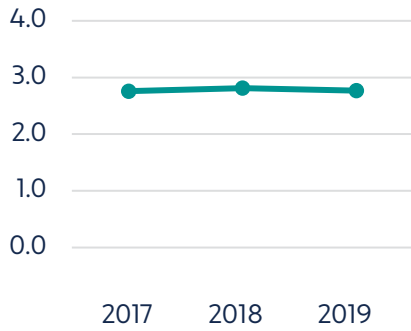

Average GPA Of Entering Students

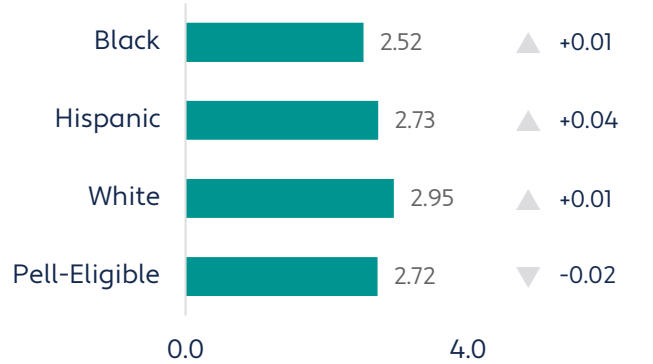
All Students



Performance Over Time

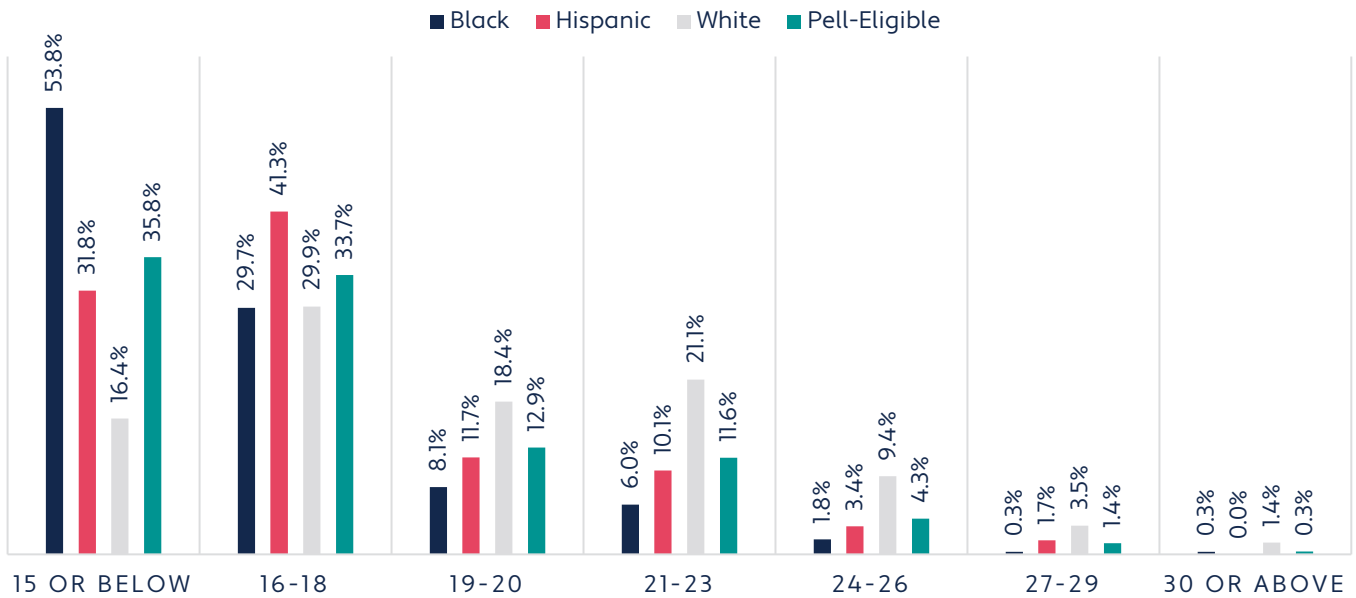

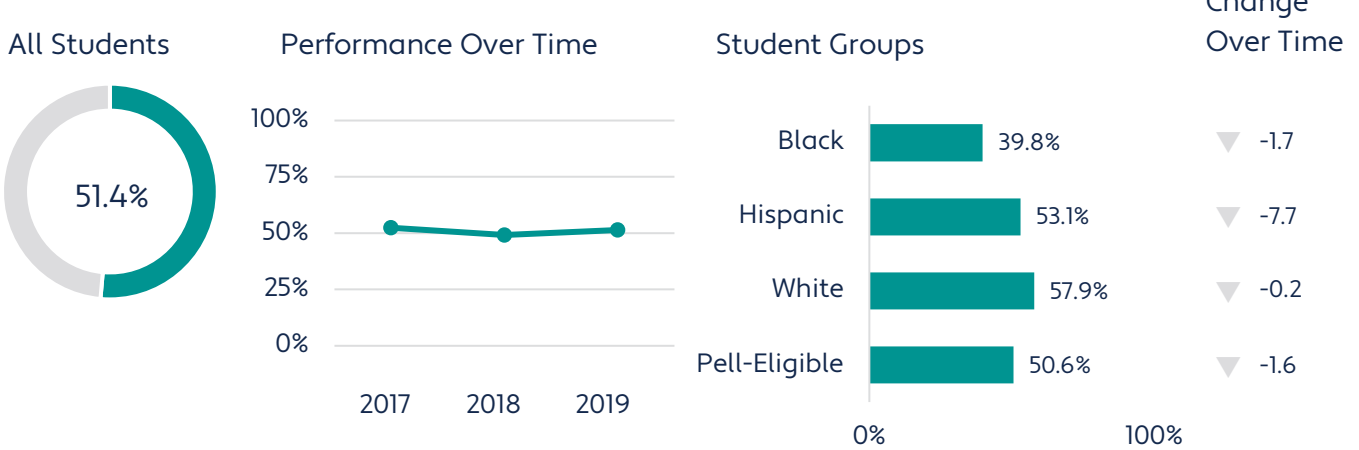
ACT Score Distribution Of Entering Students

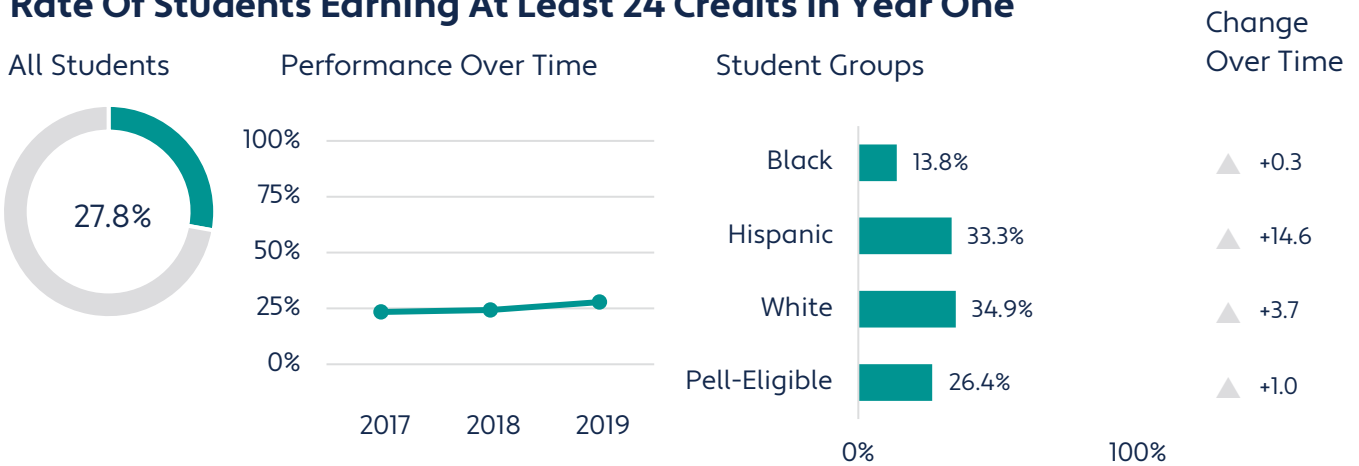


Persistence Measures

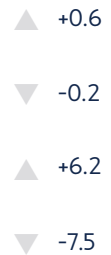
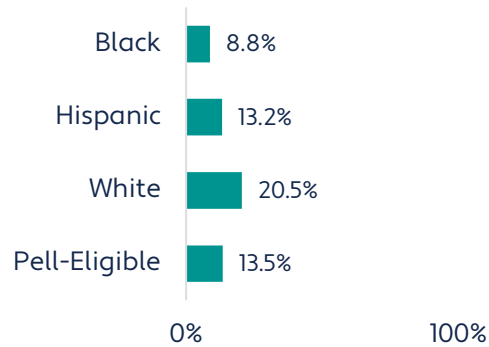
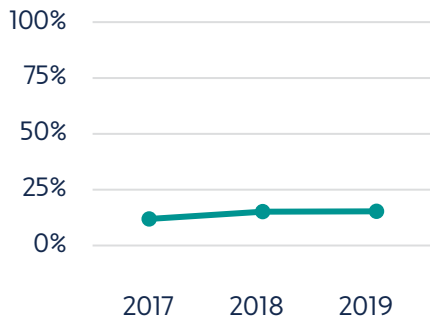
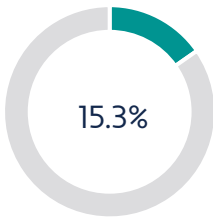
Three-Year Completion Rate
