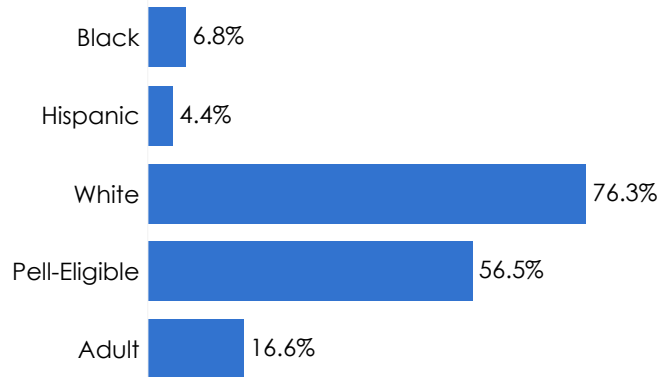

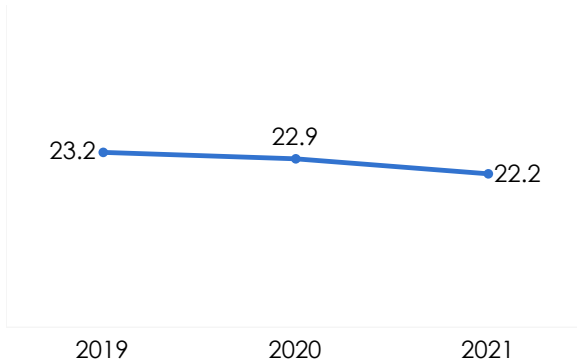
- 1** East Tennessee State University had the greatest decline in the first-to-second-year retention rate of any Tennessee public four-year institution (5.5 points).

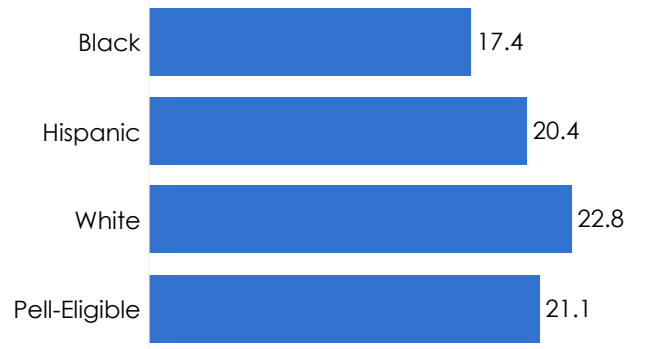

All Students Performance Over Time



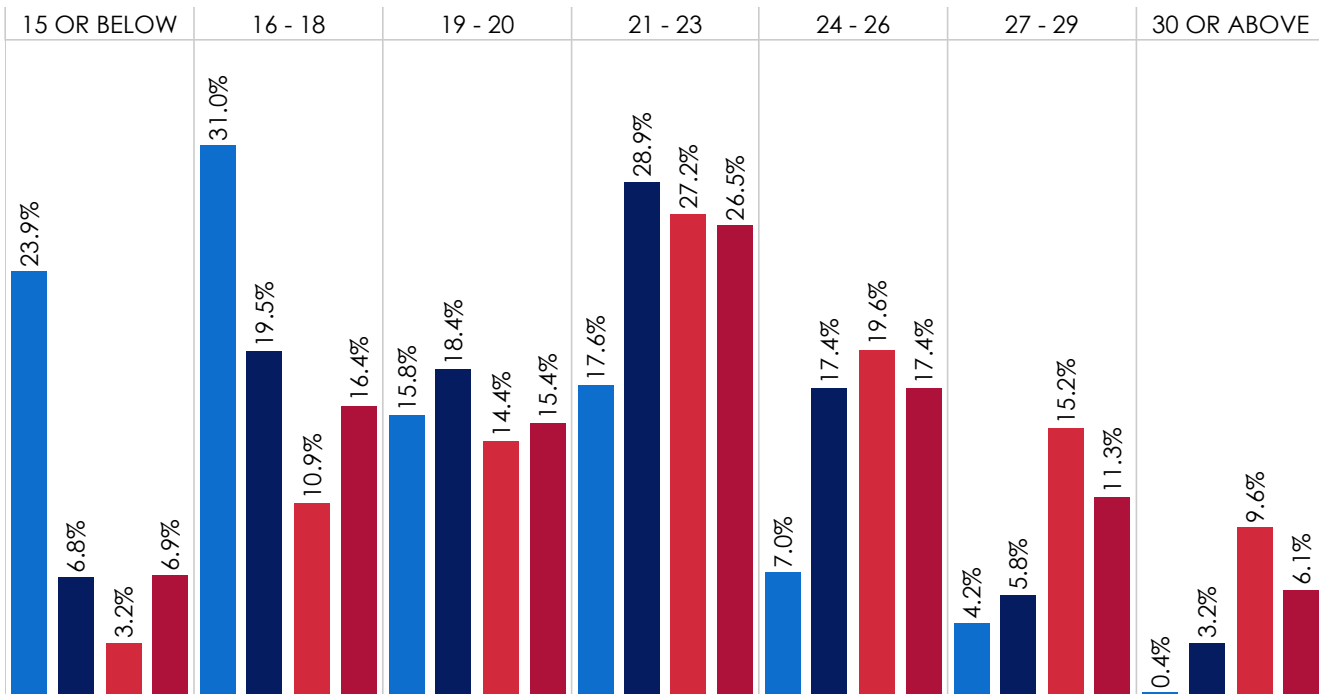
2021 Performance By Student Group

 ■ Pell-Eligible

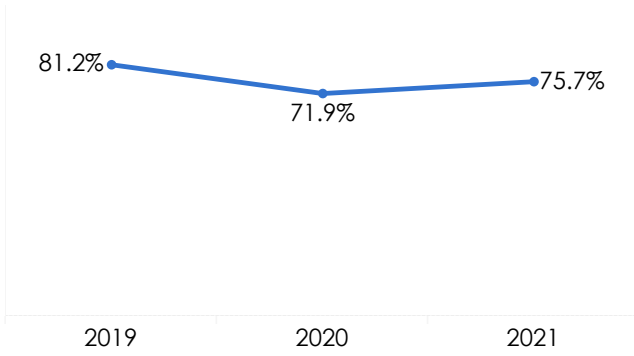

All Students Performance Over Time

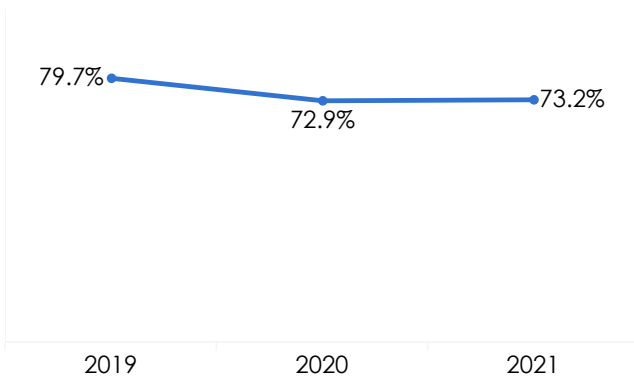


2021 Performance By Student Group

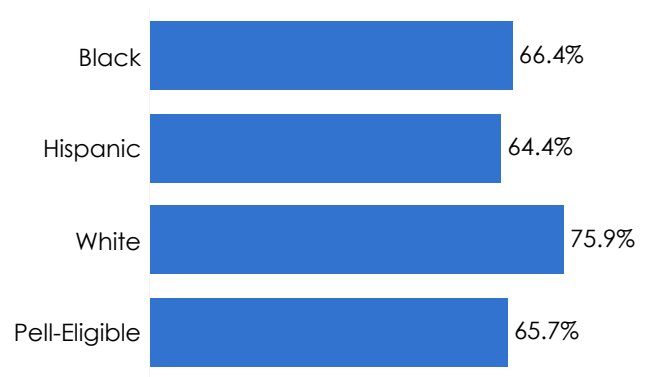


Rate Of Students Earning At Least 24 Credits In Year One

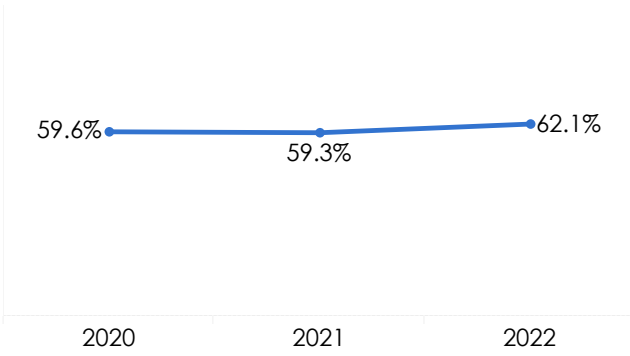

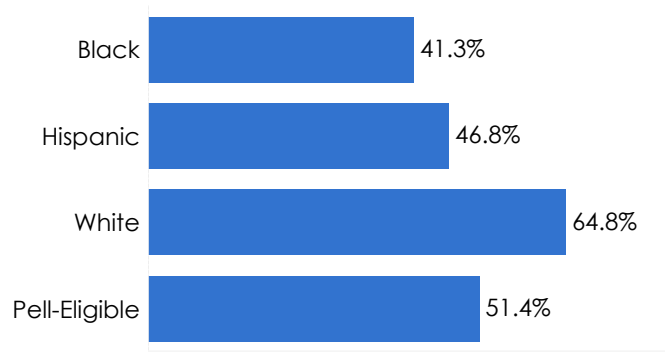

All Students Performance Over Time

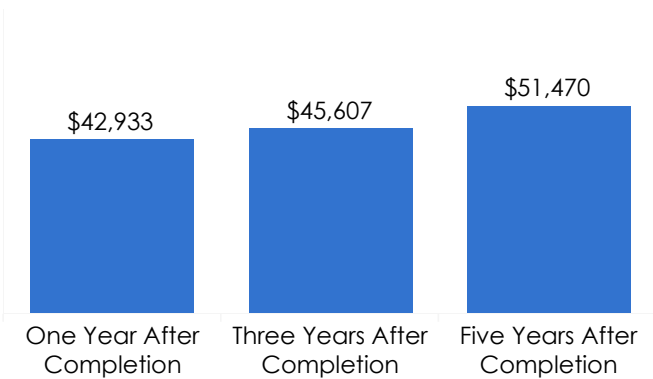


2022 Performance By Student Group
