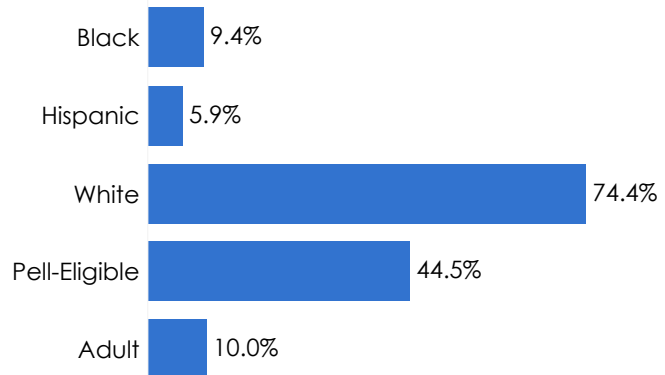

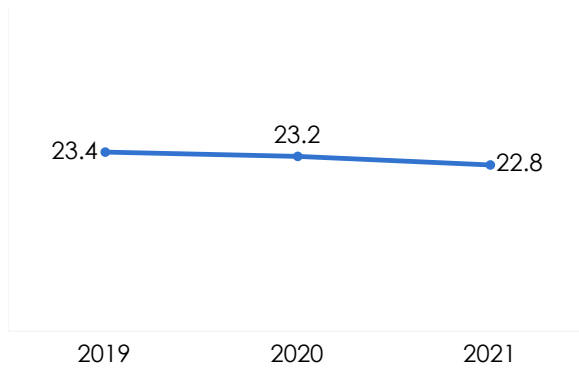
- 1** The University of Tennessee, Chattanooga had the greatest decline in the first-to-second-year retention rate of Pell-eligible students of any Tennessee public four-year institution (8.5 points).
- 2** The University of Tennessee, Chattanooga had the highest growth in the six-year graduation rate of Hispanic students of any Tennessee public four-year institution (8.5 points).
- 3** The University of Tennessee, Chattanooga had the third highest six-year graduation rate for the entering cohort of 2016 across all Tennessee public four-year institutions (66.0 percent).
- 4** The University of Tennessee, Chattanooga had the second lowest median annual wage one year post-graduation for students in the class of 2021 across all Tennessee public four-year institutions (\$40,800).

All Students Performance Over Time



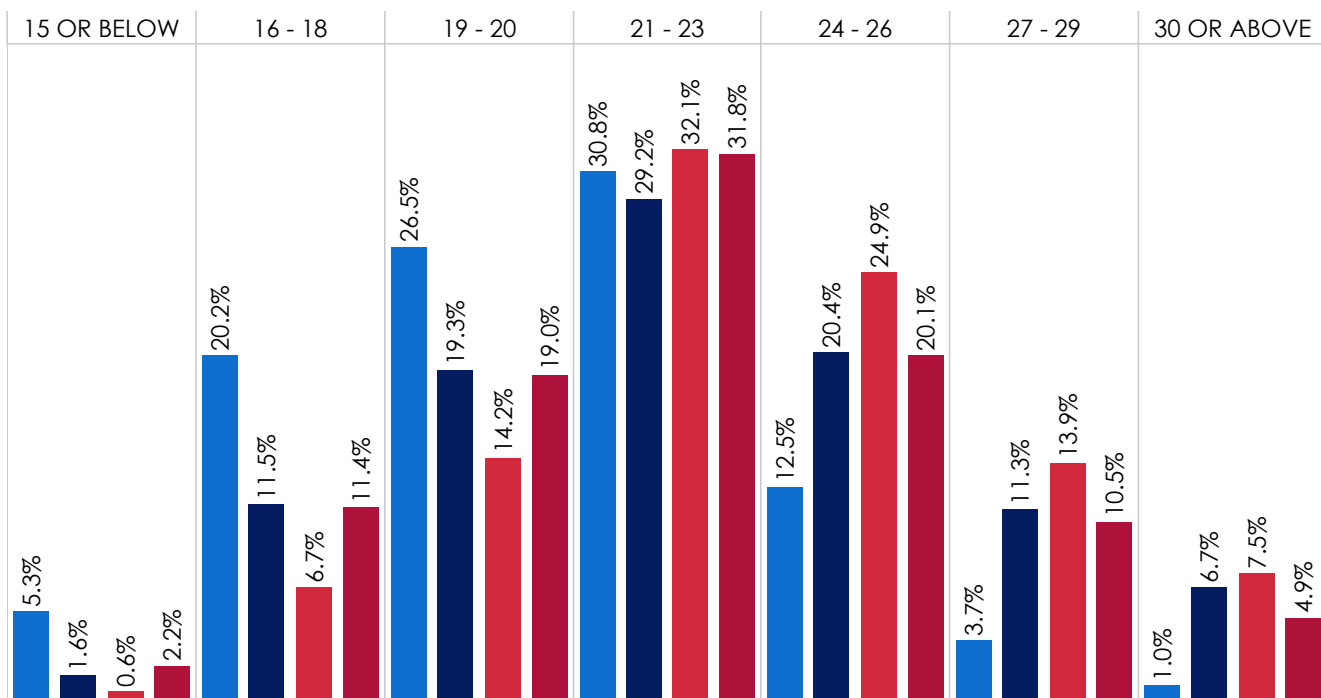
2021 Performance By Student Group

 ■ Pell-Eligible

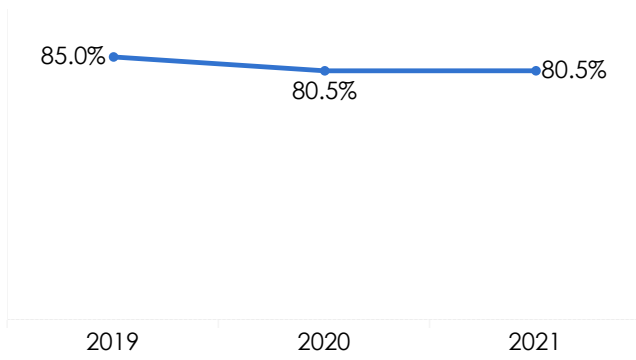

All Students Performance Over Time

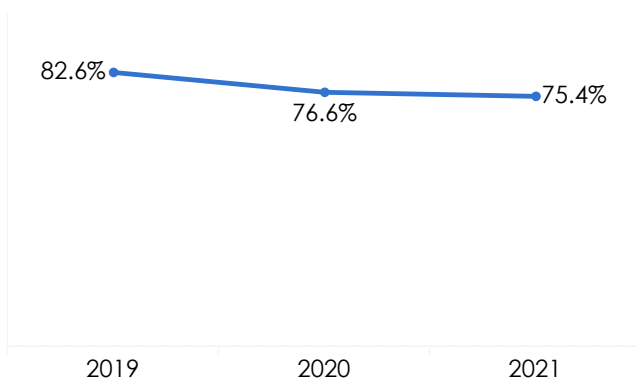


2021 Performance By Student Group

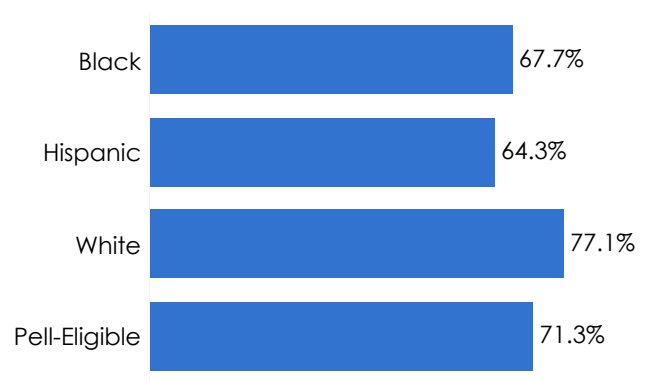


Rate Of Students Earning At Least 24 Credits In Year One

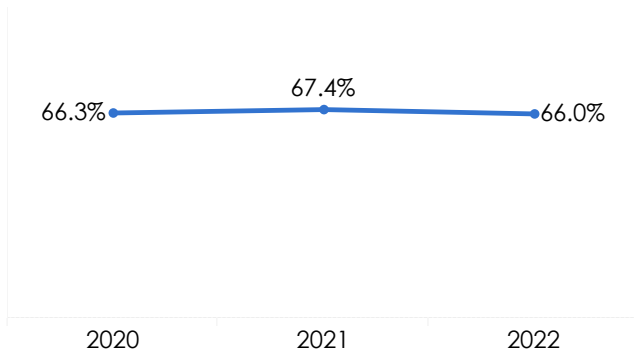

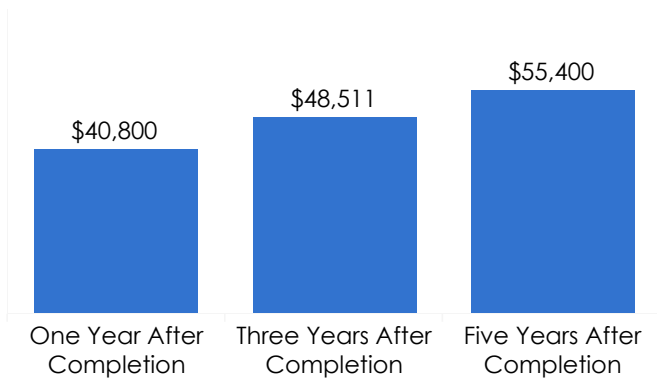


2022 Performance By Student Group
