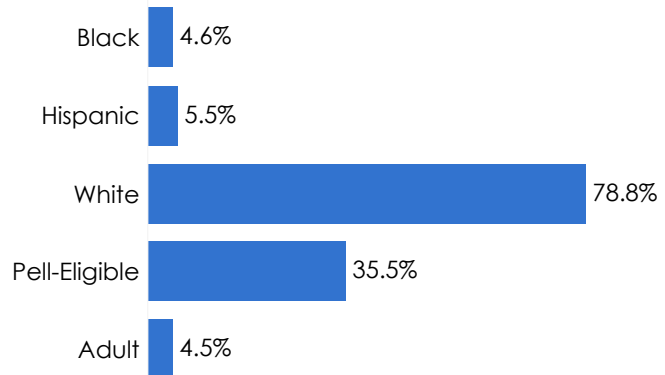

## Key Takeaways

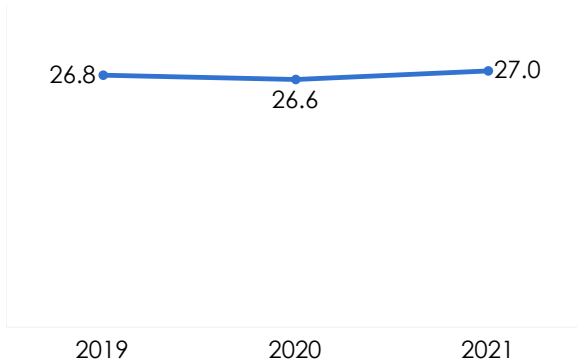
- 1** In Fall 2022, The University of Tennessee, Knoxville enrolled the lowest percentage of Pell-Eligible students of any Tennessee public four-year institution (35.5 percent).
- 2** The University of Tennessee, Knoxville had the highest first-to-second-year retention rate for the entering cohort of 2021 of any Tennessee public four-year institution (92.0 percent).
- 3** The University of Tennessee, Knoxville had the highest six-year graduation rate for the entering cohort of 2016 of any Tennessee public four-year institution (81.4 percent).
- 4** The University of Tennessee, Knoxville had the highest median annual wage five years post-graduation for Hispanic students in the class of 2017 of any Tennessee public four-year institution (\$66,600).

All Students Performance Over Time



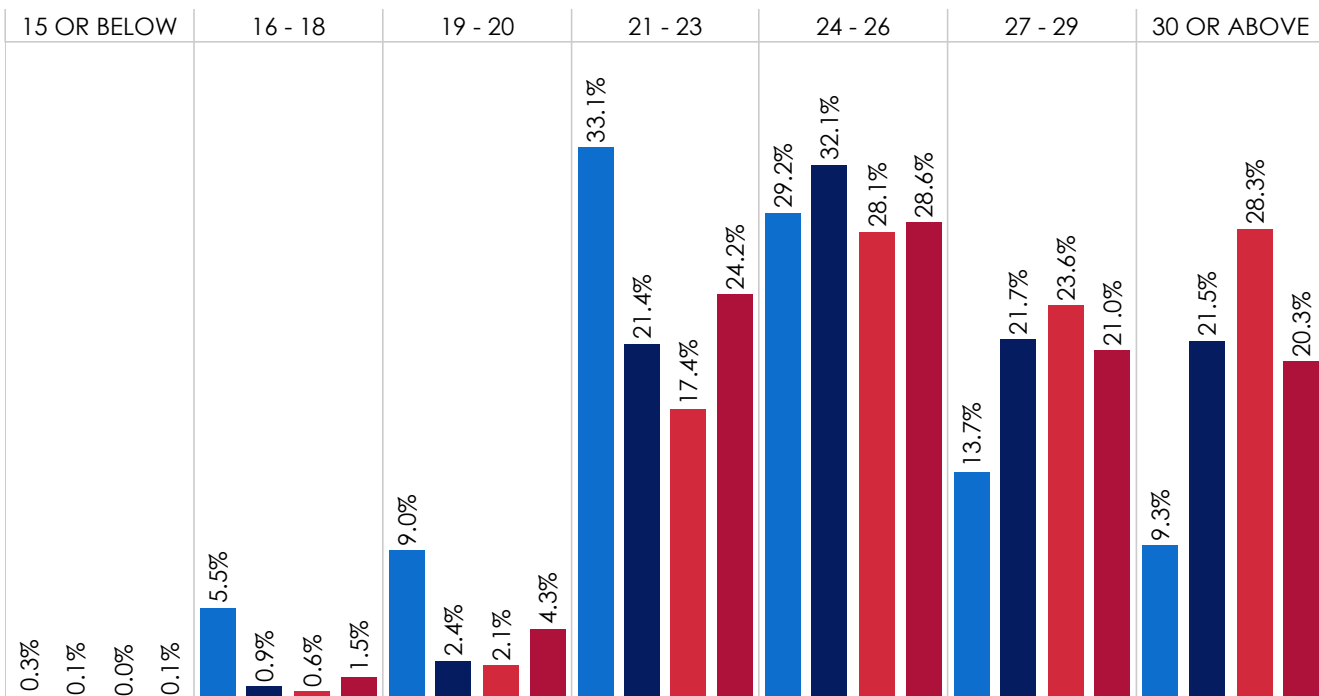
2021 Performance By Student Group

 ■ Pell-Eligible

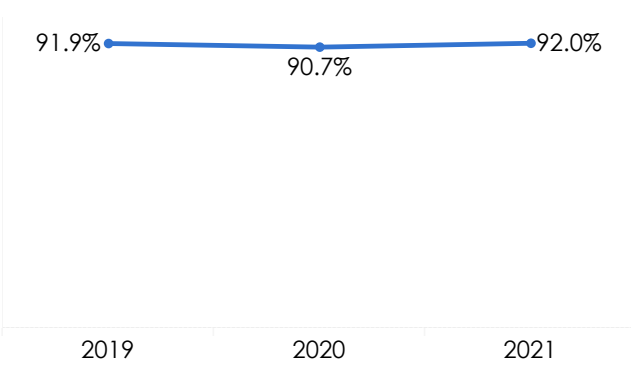




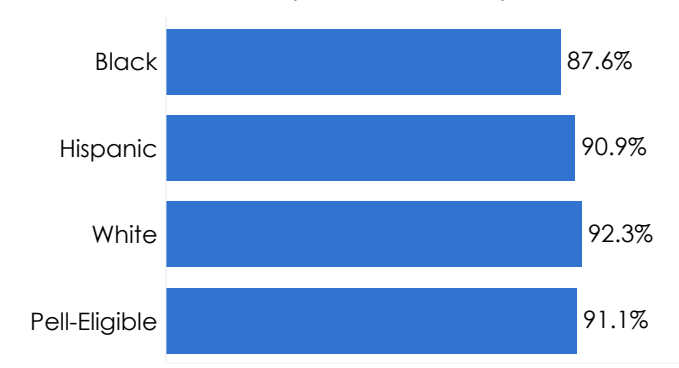

All Students Performance Over Time

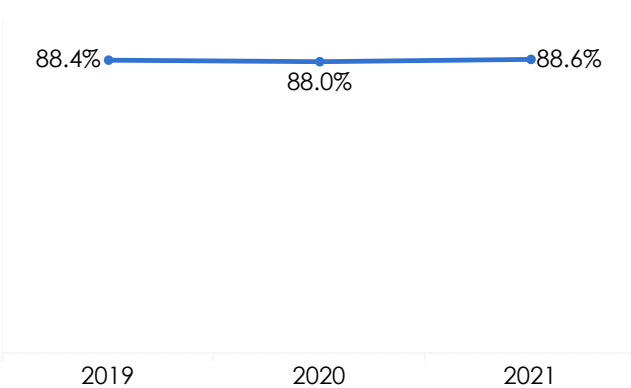


2021 Performance By Student Group

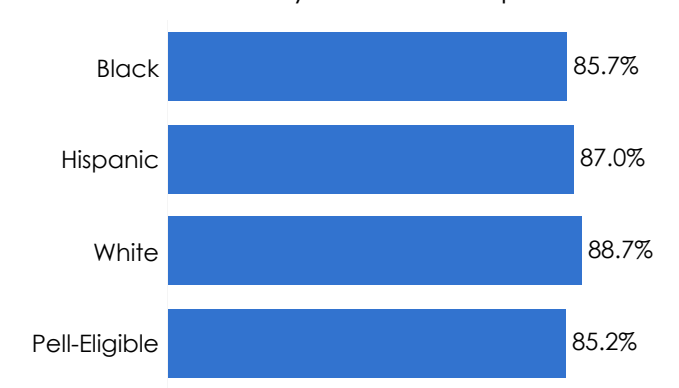


### Rate Of Students Earning At Least 24 Credits In Year One

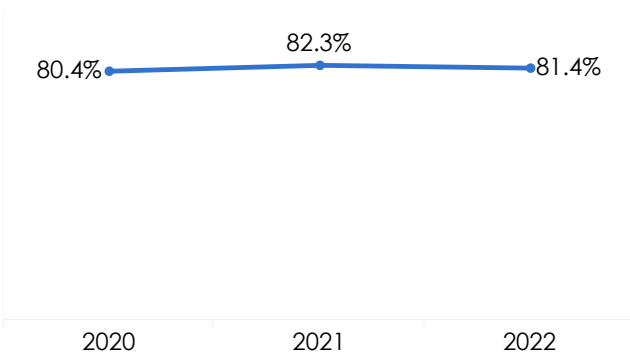

All Students Performance Over Time

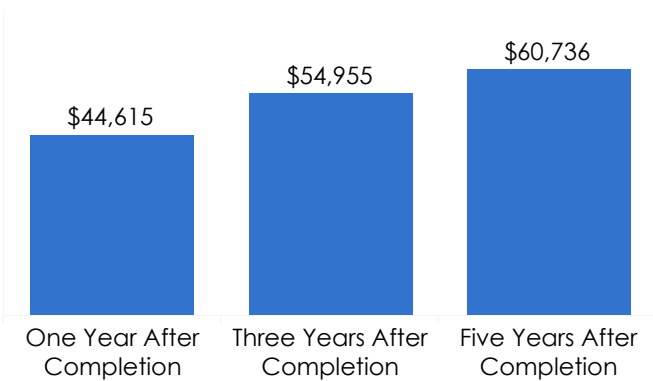


2022 Performance By Student Group
